Shall there be authorized an increase in the tax levy for the Stone County Health Department (the "Health Department") from \$0.0785 to \$0.157 per \$100 of assessed valuation of all property located in Stone County, Missouri for a period of 9 years (at which time the tax levy shall revert to the current tax levy) for the purpose of (a) constructing and improving a new Health Department facility to be centrally located in Reeds Spring, Missouri, which facility shall include a walking trail, meeting room and community garden, and (b) paying the ongoing maintenance and operating costs of the Health Department including the maintenance of the personnel required for the operation thereof?

Shall the Board of Education of the Crane R-III School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of One Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,250,000) for the purpose of providing funds to install new roofs at the old middle school and elementary school; replace heating, ventilation, and air condition (HVAC) split systems with new roof top units; increase security with new entrance doors; upgrade cafeteria and outdoor maintenance equipment; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.99 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

Shall the Board of Education of the Marionville R-IX School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds to complete the site development, construction, equipping, and furnishing of a storm shelter constructed to Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) standards to also serve as a High School music facility; to complete renovations and improvements to the Middle School Gymnasium, the Multi-Purpose Gymnasium, and the K-8 building; to complete other remodeling and repair improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.98 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

PROPOSITION A

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Community College District of Central Southwest Missouri (also known as Ozarks Technical Community College), be authorized to continue to impose an operating tax levy of \$0.05 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation, through tax year 2038, for the purposes of funding ongoing operating costs of the District, including allied health programs, technical programs and workforce development initiatives?

If this question is approved and Proposition B is also approved, the adjusted operating tax levy ceiling of the District is estimated to increase \$0.05, from \$0.15 currently to \$0.20, per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

If this question is approved but Proposition B is not approved, the adjusted operating tax levy ceiling of the District will stay the same at \$0.15 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

If this question is approved and Proposition A is also approved, the adjusted operating tax levy ceiling of the District is estimated to increase \$0.05, from \$0.15 currently to \$0.20, per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

If this question is approved but Proposition A is not approved, the adjusted operating tax levy ceiling of the District will stay the same at \$0.15 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.
